### WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

<b>Type:</b>	An investment company with variable capital incorporated with limited liability in Ireland
<b>Term:</b>	The Fund does not have a targeted closure date and may be liquidated at any time, as further detailed in the Prospectus
<b>Objectives:</b>	<p>The Barings European Loan Fund ("The Fund") seeks to provide investors with current income, and where appropriate, capital appreciation.</p> <p><b>Investment Policy:</b></p> <p>The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing primarily in senior secured loans and, to a lesser extent, senior secured bonds issued by European companies. The Fund will also invest to a lesser extent in senior secured loans and senior bonds issued by North American companies (subject to a limit of 20% of Net Asset Value). The Fund will invest at least 50% of its Net Asset Value in assets which exhibit positive or improving environmental ("E") and/or social ("S") characteristics.</p> <p><b>Share Class Currency Hedging:</b> This Share Class engages in currency hedging using derivative instruments to seek to limit the shareholder's currency risk by reducing the effect of foreign exchange rate fluctuations between the Share Class currency and the base currency of the Fund.</p> <p><b>Distribution Policy:</b> Income will be declared and distributed as a dividend quarterly.</p> <p><b>Dealing Frequency:</b> Daily. ## WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?

### Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 Years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less than your initial investment. You may have to pay significant extra costs to cash in early.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF BARING INTERNATIONAL FUND MANAGERS (IRELAND) LIMITED IS UNABLE TO PAY OUT?

The assets of the Fund are segregated from those of Baring International Fund Managers (Ireland) Limited. The Depositary is responsible for the safekeeping of the Fund's assets. To that effect, if Baring International Fund Managers (Ireland) Limited defaults, there will be no direct financial impact on the Fund. In addition, the Fund's assets shall be segregated from the Depositary's assets, which limits the risk of the Fund suffering some loss in case of default of the Depositary. You may face a financial loss if your broker or the entity from whom you purchased the Fund was to default.

As an investor in the Fund, there is no compensation or guarantee scheme in place.

## WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

### Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does.
